These applications are distributed in seven Southern Counties of California. One application will be selected by each County to submit to the Southern Division Judges, who will determine the first and second place winners. Finalists may be interviewed. The two winners will be presented at the Board of Directors luncheon meeting in June. If possible, winners should plan to attend.

Submit a typewritten essay, not to exceed 1,000 words, with your thoughts on the topic:

"Why is the U.S. Constitution unique in human history,
and why should each U.S. citizen value its contents?"

The content of your essay should reflect your knowledge of the Constitution, and what the Constitution means to you.
